Contest Rules

Application acceptance begins August 1, 2018 12:00 a.m. and ends on October 20, 2018 at 11:59 pm (Central Time). **All entries must be received in the NSRT Executive Office prior to the end date and time.**

Applicants MUST use the application found on the NSRT Web Site. Applications sent directly to the ASRT will not be considered for selection.

The contest is open only to participants who submit original essays that they have personally created. Submissions must be typed or computer-printed, and in English.

Students who have previously been selected and participated in the ASRT Student Leadership Program are not eligible to participate again.

Selection to participate in the 2019 Student Leadership Development Program is non-transferable and may not be redeemed or exchanged for cash or other alternative good or services. If selected to participate, failure to attend the program may result in the participant being billed for costs incurred by the ASRT.

Applicants selected to attend the ASRT Student Leadership Program will be contacted after November 17, 2018 and given additional instructions and details.

- Completed Application – **Use the NSRT SLDP Application found on the NSRT Web Site ONLY**
- 500-700 word essay
- Permission letter from program director
